


MAUI Song Sheet Notation, 4-Beat Song Example

SEE THIS	DO THIS
	<p>Place and pushdown fingertips of chording hand per diagram dots to form F chord. Strum all 4 strings. Horizontal rows are frets #s (1 at top; 5 at bottom). Vertical lines are strings (tuned to notes G,C,E,A, left to right).</p>
[F]	4 beats long. Play F chord, positioning fingertips of chording hand per diagram.
[]	4 beats long. Continue playing previous chord.
[] ^{NS}	4 beats long. Don't play at all. "No Strum."
[F] ^{SS}	4 beats long. Only play F chord on 1st down beat. "Single Strum."
[F] ^{DS}	4 beats long. Only play F chord on 1st & 2nd down beats. "Double Strum."
[F] ^{ChaChaCha}	4 beats long. Only play F chord on 1st downbeat, 1st upbeat, and 2nd downbeat.
[F] ^{Rasgueado}	4 beats long. Strum F chord rapidly, similar to flamenco guitar style.
[M]	4 beats long. Play muting all 4 strings with chording hand. No chord sound; only percussive.
[F] ¹	1 beat long. Play F chord.
[F] ²	2 beats long. Play F chord.
[F] Lyrics	4 beats long. Start singing lyrics on 1st downbeat while playing F chord.
[F]...Lyrics	4 beats long. Delay singing lyrics while playing F chord. Duration of delay unspecified.
<i>Bold Italics</i>	Follow performance instructions. E.g. <i>Repeat Chorus</i>
